This is the first of 12 lessons in which we will study 3 diatonic melodies in each major key. Each of the melodies, will be played through the 7 basic diatonic chords found in the major scale. These chords are: I major, II minor, IV major, V dom 7, VI minor, VII -7 flat 5.
